On Tuesday we enjoyed visiting the leisure Group in Church and sang traditional carols as they enjoyed their Christmas dinner.


On Wednesday we enjoyed praying with and singing to the Bereavement Group.

#### DREAM TEAM BED FUND

Birmingham City Council (BCC) has partnered with Birmingham Voluntary Service Council (BVSC) supported by Barnardo's to ring-fence some of the Round 4 Household Support Fund money to provide support to families suffering from Bed Poverty. This funding is currently available until 31st March, 2024.

### Families who are eligible for this referral are described as:

- · Parent sleeping on chair, sofa, or floor to give up the bed for their child
- · Child(ren) sharing bed with parents or siblings
- Child (ren) sleeping on something other than a bed floor, chair, sofa, bath, car seat etc.
- Child's bed broken and family have been unable to repair or replace in the last 6-12 months
- · Childs bed and/or bedding mouldy or damp
- Child sleeping in a bed which is inappropriate for their age range such as still sleeping in a cot or toddler bed due to inability to purchase a single bed.
