Road Harm Reduction Strategy

Birmingham City Council has launched a consultation on our <u>Road Harm Reduction Strategy</u> via Be Heard, the online consultation platform.

The strategy has been developed to complement the <u>Birmingham Transport Plan</u>. It sets out a bold approach to transform Birmingham's roads and streets to make them safer, more inclusive, and more attractive.

The ambition of the strategy is to end death and serious injury for users of Birmingham's roads in line with the Vision Zero concept, which aspires to eliminate all traffic fatalities and serious injuries. The previous <u>Birmingham Road Safety Strategy</u> was adopted in October 2016. Whilst aligned with Vision Zero, its approach did not tackle traffic volume and its significant impact on road safety.
