<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Following School routine.</li> <li>• Following School/ Class rules.</li> <li>• Making friends.</li> <li>• Sharing and helping others.</li> <li>• Talking about our feelings – what makes us happy/ sad.</li> <li>• Explaining own knowledge and understanding and asking appropriate questions of</li> </ul>

others.

Literacy



- Beginning to form recognisable letters.
- Hear, say, find and read initial sounds on words.
- Use sounds to make simple CVC words.
- Can segment the sound in simple words and blends them together.
- Listening to stories with increased attention and recall.
- Singing and saying rhymes every day to explore rhymes and rhythms.
- Writing own name and other things like labels and captions.

Maths



- Recognising numbers 1-10 and beyond.
- Counting and ordering numbers up to a set of 10 and beginning to count beyond.
- Estimating how many objects then counting to check.
- Finding the total number of objects in two groups.
- Identifying own mathematical problems based on own interests.
- Uses everyday language related to time.
- Orders and sequences familiar events.

Understanding the World



- Learning about Seasons and the differences between Autumn and Winter.
- Learning about and joining in with family customs and traditions.
- Completing simple programmes on ipads or Computers.
- Exploring growth and decay in natural things – Pumpkins.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Experimenting with different textures to make pictures.
- Learning Christmas Songs, Hymns and actions.
- Pretending to be/ role playing different characters from the story of the First Christmas.
