Maths	<p><u>Fractions Decimals and Percentages</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Use equivalents to add fractions • Add, subtract, multiply and divide simple fractions • Divide fractions by whole numbers • Solve problems using decimals & percentages •Use written division up to 2dp <p>Pupils will complete mental arithmetic tests weekly and apply their knowledge to SATs questions for each topic area.</p>
Science	The children will be studying the Classification of living things including micro-organisms
PE	There will be 4 activity groups (swimming, football, netball and gymnastics) led by the sports staff at Archbishop Ilsley.
History	The outbreak of World War II and The effect of World War II on British Life.
