'I can say sorry'

Physical Development 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Travelling with confidence and skill around, under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment. • Pushing, patting, throwing, catching and kicking objects/balls etc. • Handling tools, objects, construction and malleable materials safely and with control. • Bike riding • Holds pencil correctly and beginning to form letters and numbers.
Literacy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beginning to form recognisable letters. • Hear, say, find and read initial sounds on words. • Use sounds to write simple CVC words. • Can segment the sounds in simple words and begin to blend them together. • Listening to stories with increased attention and recall. • Singing and saying rhymes every day to explore rhymes and rhythms. • Writing own name and other things like labels and captions. • Remembering tricky words. • Essential Letters and Sounds Phonics Scheme
Maths 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognising numbers 1-10 and beyond. • Counting and ordering numbers up to a set of 10 and beginning to count beyond. • Estimating how many objects then counting to check. • Finding the total number of objects in two groups. • Identifying own mathematical problems based on own interests. • Uses everyday language related to time.
